PURPOSE

This document provides you with key information about this investment product. It is not marketing material. The information is required by law to help you understand the nature, risks, costs, potential gains and losses of this product and to help you compare it with other products.

WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

Type

Euro-Global Frontier Fund is a Sub-Fund of Flexagon UCITS Funds SICAV plc (the “Fund”). The Fund consists of separate classes of shares constituting segregated sub-funds which are segregated patrimonies. The Fund is incorporated under the laws of Malta, having its registered office at Quad Central, Q3 Level 9, Triq I-Esportaturi, Zone 1, Central Business District, Birkirkara CBD 1040, Malta and licensed by the MBR under license number SV 400.

Objectives and Investment Policy

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to realise medium to long term capital appreciation.

The Sub-Fund shall invest in a portfolio of (i) transferable securities including equities and/or bonds and/or (ii) eligible collective investment schemes and/or (iii) money market instruments, all of which may be denominated in different currencies. The Sub-Fund may invest in these asset classes either directly or indirectly through other UCITS eligible collective investment schemes and/or exchange traded funds.

Bonds will be sovereigns and/or corporates having fixed, floating or zero-coupon structures. The Sub-Fund shall not be biased towards any duration, industry or credit rating. However, it shall be biased (up to 90%) towards Central and Eastern Europe especially towards the Bulgarian domicile.

The Management Company may invest up to 100% of the assets of the Sub-Fund in equities. The Management Company is not expected to have any bias towards a specific market cap.

The Sub-Fund shall not invest more than 10% of its assets in other sub-funds of the Company. The Sub-Fund shall not invest more than 20% of its assets in units or shares of a single UCITS or other collective investment scheme.

The Sub-Fund shall not invest, in the aggregate, more than 30% of its assets in units or shares of collective investment schemes other than UCITS.

Benchmark and Strategy

The Sub-Fund does not have a reference benchmark and it is actively managed. The Management Company has full discretion over the composition of the Sub-Fund’s portfolio, subject to the investment objective, policy and restrictions stated in the Fund’s Prospectus.

Dividend policy

The Sub-Fund does not intend to distribute dividends. Any income arising from the Sub-Fund’s investments is reinvested and reflected in the value of your shares. However, the annual general meeting of shareholders may decide to distribute such income.

Term of the Product

The product has been established for an indefinite period of time. You can buy, sell and switch shares in the Sub-Fund by providing instructions within 3 business days prior the Redemption Day as outlined in the prospectus of the Sub-Fund. The Directors may in their exclusive discretion limit the total amount of redemptions effected on any Redemption Day to 10% of the outstanding Investor Shares in the Sub-Fund on that day.

Practical Information

The Sub-Fund’s depositary bank is European Depositary Bank SA Malta Branch. The NAV is calculated on Tuesday and Thursday of every week and is published on the Management Company’s website. This KID is specific to the Class of the Sub-Fund. However, the Prospectus and the annual, and half-yearly, financial reports are prepared for the entire Fund. The Prospectus is supplemented by an Offering Supplement specific to each sub-fund, including the Sub-Fund. These documents are available free of charge, in English, on the Management Company website.

Intended institutional investor

The Sub-Fund aims to meet the needs of institutional investors who want to assume medium levels of risk and are willing to hold their investment for the medium to long term.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage, and you may get back less.

You may not be able to cash in early. You may have to pay significant extra costs to cash in early. You may not be able to sell your shares in the Sub-Fund easily or you may have to sell at a price that significantly impacts on how much you get back.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this Sub-Fund compared to other Funds. It shows how likely it is that the Sub-Fund will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this Fund as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact the Sub-Fund's capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You may receive payments in a different currency to the base currency of the Sub-Fund, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

Beside the market risks included in the risk indicator, other risks may affect the Sub-Fund, including counterparty risk, credit risk, liquidity risk, operational risk and investment risk.

This table shows the money you might could get back over the next 5 years, under different scenarios, assuming that you invest EUR 10,000. The scenarios shown illustrate how your investment could perform. You can compare them with the scenarios of other products. The scenarios presented are an estimate of future performance based on evidence from the past on how the value of this investment varies and are not an exact indicator. What you get will vary depending on how the market performs and how long you keep the product. WHAT HAPPENS IF FLEXAGON CAPITAL MANAGEMENT LTD IS UNABLE TO PAY OUT?

This Sub-Fund is a sub-fund of Flexagon UCITS Funds SICAV plc, which is a Company organised under the laws of Malta as a multi fund investment company with variable share capital (SICAV). The Company consists of separate classes of shares constituting segregated sub-funds which are segregated patrimonies. The assets of the product are segregated from the assets of Flexagon Capital Management Ltd and they are deposited with the depositary. A default of Flexagon Capital Management Ltd does not have any impact on the value of your investments in the Sub-Fund.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

The person advising on or selling you the Sub-Fund may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you invest in the Sub-Fund and how well the Sub-Fund does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the Sub-Fund performs as shown in the moderate scenario
- EUR 10,000 per year is invested

(*) This illustrates how costs reduce your return each year over the holding period. For example it shows that if you exit at the recommended holding period your average return per year is projected to be 3.8% before costs and 3.3% after costs.

We may share part of the costs with the person selling you the Sub-Fund to cover the services they provide to you. They will inform you of the amount.

HOW LONG SHOULD I HOLD IT AND CAN I TAKE MONEY OUT EARLY?

Recommended holding period: 5 years

The Recommended Holding Period (RHP) of this product is 5 years which is the period over which an investment into the product is expected to break-even. Please note that this is not guaranteed. The more your actual holding period differs from the product's Recommended Holding Period, the more your actual risk of losing money will deviate from the product assumptions. If you wish, you can redeem before the RHP at the Net Asset Value of the product. Also, you might have needs and constraints implying a completely different holding period suitable to you. Thus, we recommend you discuss this point with your financial advisor. The investor can redeem their shares on every Redemption Day.
